

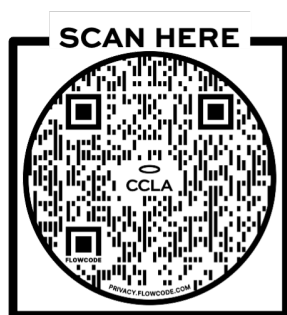

CONFESSION OF SIN:

Please sit

All: Most holy and merciful Father:

**I confess that I have sinned by my own fault
in thought, word, and deed;**

by what I have done, and by what I have left undone.

Leader: I have not loved you with my whole heart, and mind, and strength. I have not loved my neighbors as myself. I have not forgiven others, as I have been forgiven.

All: Have mercy on me, Lord.

Leader: I have been deaf to your call to serve,
as Christ served us.

All: Have mercy on me, Lord.

Leader: I confess to you, Lord, all my past unfaithfulness: the pride, hypocrisy, and impatience of my life.

All: I confess to you, Lord.

Leader: My seeking of worldly goods and comforts above my seeking of Christ.

All: I confess to you, Lord.

Leader: My negligence in prayer and worship, and my failure to share the faith that is in me,

All: I confess to you, Lord.

Leader: Restore me, good Lord, and let your anger depart from me, accomplish in me and all of your church the work of your salvation,

All: That I may show forth all your glory in the world.

Leader: By the cross of your Son, our Lord,
Bring me with all your saints to the joy of your salvation.
Amen.

ASSURANCE OF PARDON: 1 John 1:9

Leader: If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.
